In development of the 2006 budget, development of a 10 year capital plan, and in determining the annual service fee, the Board balanced the interests of the Stockholders against the long term maintenance and repair of our facilities. Hopefully, we have reached a working and equitable plan. In meeting the needs of our Senior members, those members over the age of 75 are eligible for a flat rate that will not increase in the coming years. However, we don't know the actual ages of some

of our Senior members, so we will rely on you to take the discount when making your annual service fee payment.

As always, the committees have been active all winter and we hope that many of you will join us with the upcoming projects to get the beach, dock and clubhouse ready for the summer season. We welcome all of our members who would like to become members of a committee or would like to offer help in any way. No offer will be refused and any amount of time will always be gratefully appreciated. Please check the bulletin board for events and projects and times and dates.

We have been notified by our insurance company that we will no longer be allowed to have fireworks on our beach. It has been an informal Fourth of July event that we have enjoyed over the years and we thank those who have provided the spectacle in the past. We will certainly miss the display. Unfortunately, this will not be permitted this year. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

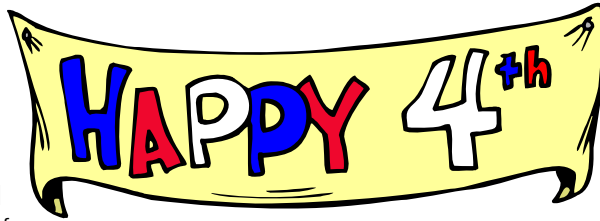
From the Editor

There has been quite a bit of slip movement on the dock this season. Welcome all newcomers to the dock, and congratulations to all of you whose time has come to receive slip upgrades. We do have some 'A' slips available for rent. If you or someone you know is interested in renting one, please contact someone on the dock committee.

Beginning this year we will be replacing some of the decking boards on the dock. This will be an ongoing project which will be done in stages. Every year we will be replacing boards starting of course with the boards in the worst condition. We have budgeted \$1000.00 per year for this project, and at today's lumber prices, this project is going to take 4 years to complete. A few donations have already been received specifically to speed up the process of completing this project.
